

JUNIOR COUNTY CUP SELECTION POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

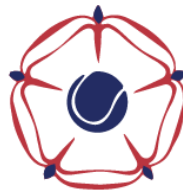
LTA County Cup events are team competitions that take place during February / March – September each year.

The information which follows outlines the dates and formats for all the junior County Cups events during 2025, along with the selection process and criteria for each. Should you have a query regarding the selection policy, please email: info@hampshireiow.tennis.

12U Born 2013 or later	Play-offs and Area Leagues: Saturday 13 th and Sunday 14 th September 2025 National Finals – Friday 26 th – Sunday 28 th September 2025	Separate events for boys and girls Team: 4 members + 2 non-travelling reserves 4 singles / 2 doubles FAST4 Top 6 ranked counties direct entry to County Cup Finals Next top 8 ranked counties placed in 2 groups with winner of each group progressing to County Cup Finals Remaining counties in area leagues (no finals)
11U Born 2014 or 2015	Play-offs and Area Leagues: Saturday 14 th and Sunday 15 th June 2025 National Finals – Friday 4 th to Sunday 6 th July 2025	Separate events for boys and girls Team: 4 members + 2 non-travelling reserves 4 singles / 2 doubles FAST4 Top 6 ranked counties direct entry to County Cup Finals Next top 8 ranked counties placed in 2 groups with winner of each group progressing to County Cup Finals Remaining counties in area leagues (no finals)
10U Green Born 2015 or 2016	Qualifying: Saturday 10 th and Sunday 11 th May 2025 National Finals – Saturday 7 th and Sunday 8 th June 2025	Separate events for boys and girls Team: 4 members + 2 non-travelling reserves 4 singles / 2 doubles FAST4 Winning team of each group progress to North or South Finals



9U Orange Born 2016 or 2017	Qualifying: Sunday 2 nd March 2025 – Girls am, Boys pm National Finals – Saturday 29 th (Girls) and Sunday 30 th March 2025 (Boys)	Separate events for boys and girls Team: 4 members + 2 non-travelling reserves 4 singles / 2 doubles FAST4 Winning team of each group progress to North or South Finals
8U Red Born 2017 or later	Saturday 26 th or Sunday 27 th April 2025	Separate events for boys and girls Team: 4 members 4 singles / 2 doubles

3. ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible players are those who are LTA members and who satisfy the area qualification rule:-
 - Born in Hampshire & IOW
 - Lived in Hampshire & IOW for at least six months
 - At any time, the place of permanent resident has been in Hampshire & IOW for a period of five consecutive years
 - Parent is serving full-time in the British Regular Armed Forces and has resided in Hampshire & IOW for at least six months
 - Not represented another County for at least six months
- Players must be of an eligible age as described in the table above to be considered for selection.

4. SELECTION COMMITTEE

- The Performance Sub-Committee will meet to select the junior teams and will consist of the following:-
 - County Performance Manager
 - County 8U, 9U & 10U Co-ordinator
 - Age-group Captain
 - Performance Sub-Committee members

5. SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection criteria are not listed in any priority order. The Performance Sub-Committee will use the following criteria as a basis for selecting each of the following age-group County Cups.

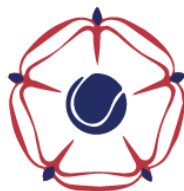
Applicable to all age group – 8U – 18U:

All players must be physically and mentally fit to play all County Cup days to achieve the best result for the County.

The Teams (18U and 14U only) will be staying in accommodation provided by the County with all other team players and Captains.

18U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 8 players to travel to the event (this includes 2 travelling reserves):-

- The top 2 available players according to 18U domestic rankings will be selected.
- The remaining 6 players will be selected based on the following:
 - Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
 - Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
 - Doubles competitive experience



- Any international and UK domestic rankings and UTR
- Positive contribution to team dynamic
- Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon ranking / UTR
- Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

14U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 6 players to travel to the event (this includes 2 travelling reserves):-

- o The top 2 available players according to 14U domestic rankings will be selected.
- o The remaining 4 players will be selected based on the following:
 - Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
 - Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
 - Doubles competitive experience
 - Any international and UK domestic rankings and UTR
 - Positive contribution to team dynamic
 - Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon ranking / UTR
 - Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

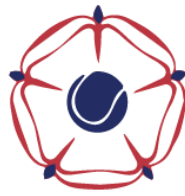
12U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 4 players to travel to the event plus 2 non-travelling reserves:-

- o The top 2 available players according to 12U domestic rankings will be selected.
- o The remaining 2 players will be selected based on the following:
 - Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
 - Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
 - Doubles competitive experience
 - Any international and UK domestic rankings and UTR
 - Positive contribution to team dynamic
 - Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon ranking / UTR
 - Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

11U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 4 players to travel to the event plus 2 non-travelling reserves:-

- o The top 2 available players according to 11U domestic rankings will be selected.
- o The remaining 2 players will be selected based on the following:
 - Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
 - Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
 - Doubles competitive experience
 - Any international and UK domestic rankings and UTR
 - Positive contribution to team dynamic
 - Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon ranking UTR
 - Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee



Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

10U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 4 players to travel to the event plus 2 non-travelling reserves:-

- Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
- Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
- Doubles competitive experience
- Recent form
- Positive contribution to team dynamic
- Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon recent form / UTR
- Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

9U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 4 players to travel to the event plus 2 non-travelling reserves:-

- Commitment to competitive tournaments – County and Regional level
- Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
- Doubles competitive experience
- Recent form
- Positive contribution to team dynamic
- Long-term (3+ months) injury or illness having a negative impact upon recent form
- Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.

8U County Cup – based on selecting a team of 4 players to travel to the event:-

- Commitment to competitive tournaments
- Performance, attitude and attendance at County Training sessions
- Positive contribution to team dynamic
- Wildcard(s) may be given at the discretion of the Performance Sub-Committee

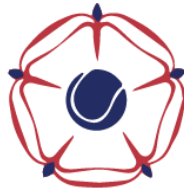
Players listed in the team are not guaranteed to play and daily selection will be at the discretion of the County Captain, which is final.
